



Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) Program

PSEO allows qualified high school students to earn college credits and, with the high school's permission, to use those credits toward the completion of your high school graduation requirements. Courses covered by the PSEO funding are offered during the fall and spring terms at the Finishing Trades Institute of the Upper Midwest. The cost for all course tuition, fees and required textbooks are covered under the PSEO program.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PSEO

Must be a Senior or Non graduating senior in high school and have an interest in “Hands On” or work-based learning.

STEP 1

Submit the following materials in person or via U.S. Mail to: **Finishing Trades Institute Upper Midwest, Attn: Office of Admissions, 3205 Country Drive Suite 105, Little Canada, MN 55117.**

ALL materials must be submitted together.

A completed and signed PSEO Application for Finishing Trades Institute of the Upper Midwest.

A current official high school transcript. (To be considered official, transcripts must be prepared and sealed by the issuing institution—or a firm acting on its behalf—in an envelope bearing the issuing institution's letterhead and submitted to FTIUM without a third party being involved in opening the document before being delivered to FTIUM.)

Records of immunizations (home schooled students only)

A Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) PSEO Program Notice of Student Registration form. Part 1 must be completed and signed. This form may be downloaded at www.ftium.edu.

STEP 2

Upon receipt of your application, you will receive a letter within 10 business days verifying your application status.

STEP 3

If all eligibility requirements have been met, you will be accepted and invited to attend Orientation. Orientation is a mandatory requirement for all high school students registering at Finishing Trades Institute Upper Midwest.
